Fixtures Report year to 30th September

Headlines

Total events 60 made up of 27 CLOK, 13 NN and 20 NATO

of which we put on 1 Major event (CompassSport Cup), 3 Nationals and 15 Regionals.

Our region put on 3 UKUL/UKOL events

For 2025, 3132 entries were made of which 2361 were by senior members and 371 junior.
Non members comprised 172 seniors and 228 juniors

Total registered activities were 12, CLOK's Couch to Green had 11 participants, 7 of whom joined the club. NN organised Tech Training 4 times.
